1. Introduction

Roundtables with regional policy and relevant stakeholders were implemented by all project partners according to the D.C.5.1 guidelines prepared by GAPR. Due to a state of pandemic and restrictions on the organization of meetings, most of the planned events took place online. The idea of the roundtable was to invite local and regional stakeholders and policy makers to discuss about KETGATE Network and each PPs regional action plans. The meeting scenario included:

- Short presentation of KETGATE (ca. 5 to 15 min) and KETGATE Points Network (The KETGATE video can be used for this purpose).
- Short presentation of the results of the pilot implementation (5 - 15 min).
- Presentation of each PPs action plans - with the emphasis on SWOT analysis and your ideas how each KETGATE Point and RTO-SME projects can be financed in the future (Success fees but also basic financing from regional institutions, innovation vouchers, etc).
- Discussion with relevant policy makers and stakeholders - topics to be addressed:
 - Strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats of the KETGATE Network concluding from action plan - discussion, finding solutions, suggestions.
 - Current status of international SME-RTO cooperation
 - Funding possibilities for the further operation of the KETGATE Network
 - Funding possibilities for further SME-RTO cooperation in the form of KETGATE Network

Each project partner adjusted the scenario of the meeting to the conditions and possibilities available in its region. Date, location and main stakeholders that took part in regional events are given in the overview table.
